

# Basic Pharmacological Terms

- ① Nausea → feeling of sickness with an inclination to vomit नाश्वरी
- ② Vomiting → ejecting matter from stomach through mouth अन्तर्दूषण
- ③ Fever → Abnormal High Body Temperature रुक्षता
- ④ Hyperuricemia → Excess of Uric acid in Blood अल्पाम्लिक
- ⑤ Ptosis → Abnormal low-lying or drooping upper eyelid अवरुद्धि
- ⑥ Hallucination → Perception of something that wasn't actually there असत्य
- ⑦ Anorexia → Reduced desire to eat खाने की इच्छा कमी
- ⑧ Epistaxis → Nosebleed नाकार्पण रक्तस्राव होना
- ⑨ Oedema → fluid Retention जूँड़
- ⑩ Hypotension → Abnormal Low Blood Pressure अल्पाम्लिक रक्तचाप
- ⑪ Hypertension → Abnormal High Blood Pressure अधिक रक्तचाप
- ⑫ Bradycardia → Slow Heart Rate (below 60 beats/min)
- ⑬ Tachycardia → Fast Heart Rate (over 100 beats/min)
- ⑭ Palpitation → Noticeable rapid, strong or irregular heartbeat उत्तित हृदयांश
- ⑮ Constipation → Difficult bowel movements असंकोहता / मालावर्करी
- ⑯ Diarrhea → loose, watery stool two or three times a day अतिसार
- ⑰ Lymphadenopathy → Disease affecting lymph nodes लेपेनोपैथी
- ⑱ Splenomegaly → Enlargement of spleen.
- ⑲ Hyperglycemia → An excess of glucose in the bloodstream अधिक ग्लूकोज़
- ⑳ Hypoglycemia → Deficiency of glucose in the bloodstream अल्पग्लूकोज़
- ㉑ Miosis → excessive constriction of pupil of the eye अप्लिया
- ㉒ Presbyopia → loss of eye's ability to focus on nearby object अप्लिया
- ㉓ Hypermetropia (Hyperopia) → Long sightedness अप्लिया
- ㉔ Xerostomia → (Dry Mouth) Abnormal Dryness of mouth from decreased secretion of saliva अप्लिया
- ㉕ Blurred → Unable to see clearly अप्लिया
- ㉖ Double Vision → Simultaneous perception of two images, (Diplopia) usually overlapping, of a single scene or object अप्लिया
- ㉗ Malaise → General feeling of discomfort, illness or uneasiness whose exact cause is difficult to identify अप्लिया
- ㉘ Tiredness → state of being tired अप्लिया
- ㉙ Biliary Spasm (Biliary Colic) → pain that occurs when gallstone is being passed & is blocking bile duct. अप्लिया

- ③① Muscles Rigidity (Muscle tension, Rigor, stiffness) → inflexibility of the muscles
- ③② Dizziness → Term used to describe range of sensation such as feeling faint, woozy, weak or unsteady.
- ③③ Vertigo → Dizziness that create false sensation that you or your surrounding are spinning or moving ~~are~~ ~~not~~
- ③④ Pruritus → Itchy skin is an uncomfortable irritation sensation that makes you want to scratch.
- ③⑤ Syncope → Temporary loss of consciousness caused by fall in Blood Pressure ~~loss of blood~~
- ③⑥ Convulsion → A shaking movement of the body that cannot be controlled.
- ④① Confusion → state of being unclear affected
- ④② Nightmares → Frightening dreams, usually during REM sleep.
- ④③ Urinary Retention → Difficult urinating and completely emptying the bladder
- ④④ Dysuria → Painful or difficult urination
- ④⑤ Libido → Person's overall sexual desire or drive for sexual activity.
- ④⑥ Dyspnoea → Difficult or laboured Breathing
- ④⑦ Drowsiness → feeling of being sleepy ~~sleepy~~ ~~sleep~~
- ④⑧ Somnolence → (Excess sleepiness) Strong desire for sleep and feeling of drowsiness ~~sleepy~~ ~~sleep~~
- ④⑨ Insomnia → persistent problems falling and staying asleep ~~fall asleep~~
- ④⑩ Fatigue → feeling overtired with low energy ~~tired~~
- ④⑪ Arthralgia → Pain in joint
- ④⑫ Tinnitus → Ringing or buzzing in one or both ears.
- ④⑬ Arrhythmia → Irregular Heartbeat
- ④⑭ Sweating → perspiration
- ④⑮ Necrosis → Death of cells or tissues through disease or injury
- ④⑯ Piloerection → Erection or bristling of hair due to the involuntary contraction of small muscles at the base of hair follicles that occur as a reflexive response of the sympathetic nervous system especially to cold, shock or fright.
- ④⑰ Acidosis → A build up of acid in bloodstream.
- ④⑱ Alkalosis → Excessive blood alkalinity
- ④⑲ Hemorrhage (Bleeding) → Release of blood from a broken blood vessel either inside or outside of body.

- 59) Ataxia  $\Rightarrow$  Impaired balance or co-ordination , can be due to damage to brain , nerves or muscles.
- 60) Arthralgia  $\Rightarrow$  Pain in joint
- 61) Euphoria  $\Rightarrow$  is experience of pleasure or excitement and intense feeling of well being & happiness.
